4 New Features for FSS Billing

CYBER Release 1.37.2.0 includes changes that will address the change in Frequency from hourly to 15 minutes for specific FSS Service Codes. The following items will be included in this release:

- The Frequency for the following FSS Service Codes will change from 1 hour to 15 minutes.
 - H0045TV22
 - H0045TV22-PPD
 - S9125HA52
 - S9125HA52-WS
 - T100522HA
 - T201322HA
- Existing FSS PPD Authorizations that have an End Date greater than 7/1/2016 will have their units multiplied by four.
 - The FSS Providers PIF will also be updated to have their Standard Units multiplied by four.
- New Authorizations created after 7/1/2016 with the following Service Codes will have the current set number of units depending on the service code multiplied by four.
 - H0045TV22
 - H0045TV22-PPD
 - S9125HA52
 - S9125HA52-WS
 - Units for the S9125HA52-WS Service Code will remain user entered.
 - T100522HA
 - T201322HA
- Authorizations created prior to 7/1/2016 that have not been sent to Molina and have a Start Date on or after 7/1/2016 will be held in a Pending status and will be modified to accommodate the new changes for Units and Frequency on FSS Authorizations.
- Authorizations that were already created and not yet fed to Molina and that have a Start Date on or after 7/1/2016 will be held in a Pending status and have their units multiplied by four and the Frequency changed to 15 minutes. On 7/1/2016 these Authorizations will be fed to Molina.
- FSS Providers PIF's will be updated to reflect the new Standard Units for the following FSS Service Codes and they will also have the Rate (Cost Per Unit) field blanked out:
 - H0045TV22
 - H0045TV22-PPD
 - S9125HA52
 - T100522HA
 - T201322HA
- The Rate (Cost Per Unit) for the following FSS Service Codes will be removed from the system:

<p>FB 20746 WO 176447</p>	<p>Issue: When the user transfer any plans within the agency user - the other user doesn't get this plan in their My Plan grid instead it displays in the Filtered Plan grid.</p> <p>Resolved: When a plan or assessment has been transferred to another user within their Agency the plan appears in the My Plans section of the Plan Approval screen as expected for the assigned user.</p>
<p>FB 13940 WO 123515</p>	<p>Issue: On the Welcome Page under the link New to Youthlink the system is displaying referrals that do not match the Provider's PIF.</p> <p>Resolved: The link for New to Youthlink is displaying referrals as expected based on the Provider's PIF.</p>
<p>FB 20720 WO 176066</p>	<p>Issue: CSA Admins have the ability to edit the Details tab of a Medicaid Providers Provider Details screen if they have the security group ProviderDetailsEdit.</p> <p>Resolved: Only CSOC users have the ability to edit the Details tab for a Medicaid Provider.</p>
<p>FB 20726 WO 164280</p>	<p>Issue: FSS users were unable to add claims for specific youth. When the user tried to add a claim they received a pink window pop up screen labeled Select Organization Requiring Access to Document without any program for the user to select.</p> <p>Resolved: The Agency has been added to the cross reference table so that the user no longer receives the screen and the Program is automatically attached.</p>
<p>FB 20750 WO 176595</p>	<p>Issue: On the facesheet's Eligibility tab, the Connect and Disconnect buttons are not performing as expected.</p> <p>Resolved: The Connect and Disconnect buttons have been fixed and are working as expected for users with the appropriate security.</p>
<p>FB 20757 FB 20759 WO 176655 WO 176675</p>	<p>Issue: A UCM is attempting to associate a BHHQPUUpd assessment to a CR90D Treatment plan but the QPU is not displayed in the ASSOCIATE BHH PROGRESS UPDATE accordion as expected. Any BHH QPU submitted within the last 30 days should be available to the UCM for association.</p> <p>Resolved: UCM users are able to associate BHHQPU's to the CR90D as expected.</p>
<p>FB20703 WO 175272</p>	<p>Enhancement: The following OOH Facility/Program Types have been added to the Geo-mapping:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. EDRU 2. EDR-IDD 3. Intensive-IDD

FB20725 WO 175894	Issue: The CSC26 Authorization is not getting created upon the approval of a JCR. Resolved: The auto Authorization for CSC26 on the approval of a JCR is working as expected.
FB 20745 WO 176383	Issue: After the Hot Fix 1.37.1.1 users were not able to save added medications in the BHH Nursing Assessment. Resolved: Users are able to save added medications to the Nursing Assessment as expected.
FB 20748 WO 165686	Issue: Users with the Security Group CMONURS are displaying as a Case Manager on the Demographics tab of the Treatment Plans. Resolved: Users that only have the Security Group CMONURS will no long display in the Case Manager field on the Demographics tab of the Treatment Plan.
FB 20755 WO 175792	Issue: When a user attempts to add a diagnosis code in a FSS claim that has been returned to them the newly added diagnosis is not being saved upon submission. Resolved: Diagnosis codes are being saved to the FSS claims as expected.
FB 20761 WO 175458	Issue: When new sites are added to site details in an AAA and approved, they partially populate the PIF; however, town, zip and county are missing. Resolved: The PIFs now capture the Site contact person, phone or email and the City, Zip and County from the AAA Site Details.
FB 20762 WO 176942	Issue: FSS PIFs are displaying Zip Codes selected that are outside of the Counties selected. Resolved: If the user deselects a County on the FSS PIF and saves the changes to the PIF the corresponding Zip Codes will be removed from that Providers PIF. If the user wishes to add those back to the PIF they must select the County, save and all of the Zip Codes from the corresponding County will be displayed and selected.
FB 20687 WO 175179	Enhancement: A popup has been added to the FSS application which will appear if the youth has a Tracking Element for MLTSS stating the following “Youth has an MLTSS Tracking Element. A FSS Application should not be completed for this youth.”
FB 20773	Issue: On the Authorization screen of a youth’s Facesheet the screen is displaying a string of FSS entries under the Provider column instead of just displaying FSS once. Resolved: The system is now display the name of the Provider as expected on the Authorization screen of a youth’s Facesheet.
FB 20778	Request: The following Providers have had their Units Remaining and Units Per Year changed to unlimited “9999”
