The following items were fixed and have been included in this release.

FogBugz #/ Work Order #	Description
FB 22885 WO 200917	Issue: CSA users are not able to sort the Application ID column in the Camp Documents Forms grid. Resolved: CSA users are now able to sort by clicking on the column header Application ID in the Camp Documents of the Forms grid.
FB 22886 WO 201073	Issue: CSA created Camp/One-to-One Applications and Requests are not being displayed in the Portal for CSA users. The Requests are displaying correctly in CYBER, however, when the user is navigated to the Portal to review the selected Request the selected Request/Application is not displayed and there is no youth in the Current Registered Children grid. Resolved: CSA created Applications/Requests are now appearing in the Applications grid of the Portal correctly and can be viewed by both the CSA and the Portal user if a selected youth is attached to a person Portal account.
FB 22898 WO 201303	Issue: Authorizations for Camp/One-to-One were being created with an incorrect number of Units from the Approved Camp/One-to-One Request.

	Resolved: The Authorizations for Camp/One-to-One are correctly calculating the number of units on the Approved Camp/One-to-One Request.
FB 22899	<p>Issue: If a user uploads a document to the Camp/One-to-One Request that has an apostrophe (') in the file name of the document the system prevents anyone from reopening the document once it has been attached to the Request.</p> <p>Resolved: Users are able to open documents that have been attached to a Camp/One-to-One Request as expected even with special characters in the file name.</p>
FB 22895 WO 201275	<p>Issue: CSA users cannot edit a Camp/One-to-One Request. CSA users should be able to edit any Camp/One-to-One Requests.</p> <p>Resolved: CSA users are able to edit a Camp/One-to-One Request as expected.</p>
