4 New Features

CYBER Release 1.40.0.0 includes changes for the FSS Link screens for CSA, CSOC, FSS users as well as modifications to the FSS Welcome Page. This release will also include a new FSS Site Transfer form that will allow for a youth to be transferred from one site to another site within the same FSS Agency that has the same Service Type without the need for a new FSS Application. The following items are included in this release:

- ❖ Referrals will no longer automatically be placed in a FSS Provider’s Provider Queue.
 - Referrals will not be automatically displayed in the FSS Link tab.
 - All Family Level of Need (previously Rating) referrals will be displayed at the same time.
 - Users will still need to take an action on all of the High referrals before they can take an action on the Moderate referrals.
 - There is a new referral status labeled “Assigned to Queue.”
 - The following statuses will be displayed in the Provider Queue tab only:
 - Assign to Queue
 - Review
 - Schedule

- ❖ FSS Providers will only be allowed to have a maximum 20 referrals for each program in a Review and/or Schedule status.

- ❖ Referrals that are in a Schedule status for 7 calendar days for the following Service Types will have the referral automatically switched back to an Assign status:
 - AASR
 - AHR
 - AWRAO
 - AWR
 - OVR

- ❖ Referrals that are in a Schedule status for 21 calendar days for SHR Service Type will be automatically switched back to an Assign status.

- ❖ FSS users will now be able to view and reassign previously Not Accepted referrals from the FSS Link tab.

- ❖ There will be a new tab labeled “Assignment History” on the FSS Link screens.

- ❖ Language in the FSS Link screens and Progress Notes using the term “Discharge” will be changed to “Transition.”

- ❖ Language in the FSS Link screens, FSS Application and Progress Notes using the term “Rating” will be changed to “Family Level of Need.”

- ❖ FSS Providers as well as CSA users with the security Group CSAFSSADM will now be able to request a transfer for youth from one FSS Program to another within the same Agency with the same Service Type by creating a new FSS Site Transfer Form.
 - The FSS Site Transfer Form will be accessible on the youth’s Forms grid.
 - When the FSS Site Transfer Form is submitted, it will be automatically approved and the following actions will be performed automatically by the system:
 - The system will automatically update the Admissions records as well as the Tracking Elements for the youth.
 - The system will generate and commit a FSS Service Summer Progress Note with information from the FSS Site Transfer Form.

- ❖ Changes have been made to the current FSS Link View Welcome Page links to display the changes made to the FSS Link screens.

- ❖ The CSA will now be able to select exclusive FSS Providers to assign the youth’s referral to.

- ❖ The CSA will now be able to Cancel a FSS Application and the Services requested within.

FB 23057	<p>Issue: On the Formal/Informal Supports tab of a youth’s record, users can Add a new Family/Support member to the grid by using an ID of zero and clicking Accept. This allows the user to incorrectly add a record without using the Add New screen.</p> <p>Resolved: A validation has been added to prevent users from using an ID number of 0 on the Add Family/Support Member screen.</p>
FB 23063	<p>Issue: The Submitted to CSA Date is populating with “9999/09/09 00:00:00” when the Treatment Plan is transferred and returned to users through Historical Access.</p> <p>Resolved: The Submitted to CSA Date is populating as expected.</p>
FB 23085	<p>Issue: In the Miscellaneous Stipulations section of the AAA, the print has older</p>

FB 23111	<p>Issue: In the UMSR, on the OOH IOS tab the specifiers grid has the selection “Substance Use” misspelled as “Sustance Use”</p> <p>Resolved: The spelling has been corrected to display “Substance Use.”</p>
FB 23123 WO 209313	<p>Issue: When exporting Agency Cases to Microsoft Excel 97-2003 users are receiving the following error “This implementation is not part of the Windows Planform FIPS validated and cryptographic algorithms.”</p> <p>Resolved: Users can export to older version of Excel as expected.</p>
FB 23125 WO 209416	<p>Issue: When a user creates a SNA and is open to multiple Programs, the user receives the Select a Program screen with a “Please wait one moment” window on top. The loading window should not appear until after the user selects the Program.</p> <p>Resolved: The loading window is no longer appearing when the Select a Program screen opens until after the Program has been selected.</p>
FB 23243 WO 211759	<p>Issue: FSS users can backdate their Discharge (Transition) to a date prior to the youth being admitted to their Program.</p> <p>Resolved: A validation has been implemented to prevent FSS users from backdating the Discharge date prior to the youth’s admission date.</p>
